**MEETING HERE OUSTS REDS****Russian Group Expels 5 Delegates  
and Two Reporters.**

Five Communist delegates and two Communist newspaper representatives were expelled from the convention of the Russian Consolidated Mutual Aid Society, which ended its deliberations at 2 o'clock yesterday morning, it was announced by M. Komiakoff, secretary. The meeting was held at the headquarters of the association, 315 East Tenth Street.

One hundred and one delegates from various parts of the country discussed plans for assisting needy Russians. It was charged that the five Communist delegates had attempted to swing the convention toward a pro-Soviet policy. The two reporters from Communist papers, according to Komiakoff, were ejected after policemen had been called upon their refusal to leave the hall.
