Application is hereby made for approval of the following amendment to the above numbered application, with the stipulation that this amendment is to become a part of the aforesaid original application and subject to all the conditions, agreements, and statements therein contained.

It is proposed to construct a two story extension at rear of building according to accompanying drawings.

Said extension is not to exceed fourteen feet in height (12) measured from curb to underside of roof beams. Reconsideration requested that survey be disregarded as proposed extension is only fourteen and that rear wall of rear adjacent property is 12' from the rear lot line of said premises.

- 13. New schedule of unoccupied space now filed, also for increased number of rooms.
- 14. Light and ventilation of first floor not to be diminished.
- 15. Rooms to contain not less than 70 sq. ft. and their finished measurements over all as now shown.
- 16. Means of cross ventilation now provided for new bed room.
- 17. Proposed room in basement to be used for storage purposes. Closets to be constructed as per plans.
- 18. Reconsideration requested that fire escapes remain in present location.
